Jane Adams Breed Gallery- Two for the Show– *Marian DeBerry and Becky Tubbs*

The Breed Gallery will feature Signature Artist Members Marian DeBerry and Becky Tubbs in their exhibition, ***Two for the Show***, a collection of paintings. Both artists enjoy experimenting with new ways to create traditional realism. Becky works in watercolor, oil and acrylic collage, while Marian primarily works in watercolor and batik. The Exhibit opens July 6th with a member's opening reception that evening from 6-8pm.

Gallery 2- Aftermath- Bosnia's Long Road to Peace – *Sara Terry*

Aftermath: Bosnia's Long Road to Peace explores the human costs and consequences of war—not on the battlefield, but in its aftermath, which is where the painful work of true peace-making begins. Photographer Sara Terry's long-term project about the aftermath of war in Bosnia -- "Aftermath: Bosnia's Long Road to Peace" -- was published in September 2005 by Channel Photographics. Her work has been widely exhibited, at such venues as the United Nations, the Museum of Photography in Antwerp, and the Moving Walls exhibition at the Open Society Institute. She is represented by Polaris Images.

Broken Patterns: Nature Interrupted will feature The Center's Artist Members in a group exhibition in Gallery 3 during June and July. The exhibit features artist members Linda Murray, Becky Tubbs, Mike Lanier, and many more.
